### How To Register for JOM Assistance

1. Student must be enrolled with JOM Program.
2. Educational Support Form must be completed by parent, and signed by a school official (secretary, principal, teacher or counselor), if request is an educational support item.
3. Request must be approved by local JOM Parent Committee or the Tribes Indian Education Committee. If JOM community is underrepresented.
4. Make sure we have supported documents for request, vendor information, and the cost (documentation that shows cost).
5. The request process can take one week to receive payment, or may take up to two weeks depending on approval.
6. Always call on the status of your request.

### How To Apply for Tribal Services

1. Submit tribal JOM gaining application on behalf of your student. JOM gaining applications are available on our tribal website at: [www.c-a-tribes.org/johnson-omalley](http://www.c-a-tribes.org/johnson-omalley)
2. Submit copy of student tribal (CDIB) card, Certification of Indian Blood.
3. Submit supporting documentation such as school letter stating student participates in school related sports or class, or class schedule showing class, invoice from vendor or receipt showing costs if a reimbursement is required.

Once all information is received request will be processed, it may take one to two weeks to receive payment. Please call our office to make sure we have received all paperwork to process your request.



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## CHEYENNE AND ARAPAHO TRIBES JOHNSON O'MALLEY PROGRAM

The C&A Tribes Johnson O'Malley Program is a federally funded program and is a supplemental program that assist with the unique educational needs of the student. Each year the Tribes receive funding for all eligible Native American students attending a public school or attending one of the Tribes Head Start Programs and who live within the Tribes nine county service area. The list of communities we serve are Calumet, Canton, Canton Head Start, Concho Head Start, Clinton, Clinton Head Start, Darlington, Elk City, Enid, Geary, Hammon, Kingfisher, Mustang, Seiling, Thomas, Watonga, Weatherford, Woodward, and Yukon. We have local JOM Parent Committee's who assist the JOM Coordinator in providing the needs of their students within their respective communities. The parents who are elected to serve as a parent officer must have a child enrolled with the JOM Program. All parents are encouraged to attend your local JOM meetings, and volunteer your time with special activities. The JOM Program encourages parental involvement.

**PLEASE NOTE:** All Parent Officers must sign a Code of Ethics form, and will be required to participate in JOM Training.

### JOM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

STUDENT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING, ¼ OR MORE INDIAN BLOOD, SHOW PROOF OF ENROLLMENT WITH A COPY OF CDIB (CERTIFICATE OF DEGREE OF INDIAN BLOOD).

MUST ATTEND PUBLIC SCHOOL AND RESIDE WITHIN THE CHEYENNE & ARAPAHO TRIBES SERVICE AREA. STUDENTS ENROLLED WITH A TRIBE BY DESCENDENCY MUST SHOW PROOF BY CDIB OR PARENT'S CDIB. IF CHILD IS NOT ENROLLED AND IS ¼ OR MORE DEGREE OF INDIAN BLOOD A COPY OF CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE TO SHOW RELATIONSHIP WITH ENROLLED PARENT, SUCH TRIBES AS CHEROKEE, CHOCTAW, CHICKASAW, CREEK, AND SEMINOLE TRIBES OF OKLAHOMA WHO DO NOT HAVE A BLOOD QUANTUM ARE ELIGIBLE FOR JOM.
